The 100 saplings have arrived in school! They are currently being stored outside and kept moist ready for tree planting day. They are a mixture of plants for hedging (blackthorn, hawthorn and hazel) and trees (rowan and silver birch). They are small, approximately 30cm in height so hopefully will be easy to plant! We have also been provided with canes and tree guards. The trees will be planted in a field in Askwith which has kindly been made available to us. We plan to plant the hedging plants along the fence line and then space the trees behind.

Residents of Askwith will be helping as well as some of the children and staff but other volunteers are needed. Parents / grandparents / carers all welcome!! If you are planting, please bring a trowel or a spade.
