<b>Ongoing learning: this homework can be completed at any time throughout the term.</b>		
<b>Philosophy</b> Think about your friends in school and at home. Create a poster showing how to be a good friend.	<b>PE</b> How can you make sure you keep fit and healthy? Make a list of the different ways you keep fit and healthy	<b>Music</b> Listen to a piece of music and write down or draw a picture to show how it made you feel.
<b>New topics: this homework can only be completed after input at school - a dot will be added to let you know when it can be completed.</b>		
<b>Science</b> Create an experiment to show what plants need to grow.	<b>RE</b> Read a story with a meaning or lesson behind it - what did you learn from this story?	<b>Art and Design</b> Choose your favourite piece of Van Gogh artwork. Why is it your favourite piece?
<b>Geography</b> Can you find and label the seven continents and five oceans on a map?	<b>History</b> Research why Guy Fawkes was an important part of British History.	<b>English</b> What is your favourite fairy tale or traditional tale? Explain why - you can write about it, draw a picture, or both.

Homework for Year 2 alternates between the grid above and the maths homework.

One week each child in Year 2 should choose one homework task from this grid. Homework can be written, be in picture form, can be drawn or photographs can be stuck in the purple homework books, depending on the task.

The following week each child from Year 2 should complete the task set from the Maths Homework Book. The page number will be written in their purple homework book.
