Painting (Artist: Kandinsky, Text: Brown Bear, Brown Bear)

• Know:

- paint can be applied in different ways using:
 - body parts: fingers, hands, feet
 - brushes, sponges, card, sticks
- colours can be matched to their purpose
- when two colours are mixed together, a new colour is made

Collage (Text: Little Red Riding Hood)

Know:

- how to use scissors (see fine motor development)
- how to use a glue stick effectively (see fine motor development)
- that a collage is a range of materials glued onto a background
- that a variety of materials can be used in a collage:
 - paper and magazine cuttings
 - fabric
 - recycled objects

Printing (Artists: Danya Banya and Cassandra Tondro)

- that marks and simple patterns can be created using natural and manmade materials
- how to create free-form patterns by:
 - rolling printing inks over found objects
 - using pressure to press the object down onto paper
 - rolling printing inks over stencils and mesh
