

## Homework Tasks Class 2 (Year 1) - Spring Term

Draw a picture and write a sentence about what you did at the weekend.	Can you write some numbered instructions about how to make a food item of your choice e.g. a cheese sandwich?	Can you draw a picture of some healthy foods and label them?
Can you use some weighing scales at home to weigh 4 objects and record their weight?	Can you paint a picture of your favourite animal? Think carefully about what colours you need.	Have you ever played any team games like football, rugby, netball, hockey or rounders? Can you draw a picture of you playing the game and write a sentence about what you liked about it?
<b>To be completed after the end of January</b> Can you find/print or draw a picture of an animal that is a carnivore, herbivore and omnivore? Make sure you label them.	<b>To be completed during Spring 2 (March)</b> Can you practise the song 'London's Burning' at home? Could you include some instruments in your performance?	<b>To be completed during Spring 2 (March)</b> Can you find a picture of the UK to look at? Write a list of the 4 countries in the UK. Can you locate their capital cities?

In Year 1 homework will follow a 2 weekly cycle. The children will alternate between choosing a homework task from the grid above, then a maths homework task. They will complete both in their Homework Book. When homework has been completed the box can be coloured in to show it has been completed.

Homework can be written (**at least one sentence including capital letters, full stops, gaps between words and spelling using phonics as much as possible**), pictures can be drawn or photographs can be stuck in the Homework Books.

**Homework should be returned on a Wednesday and new homework will be issued on a Friday.**
