

## Homework Tasks Class 2 - Autumn Term

<b>Ongoing learning: this homework can be completed at any time throughout the term.</b>		
Go on a nature hunt - can you find 5 different types of plants/flowers/trees?	Draw your favourite character from a traditional tale. Can you label it?	Draw or paint a picture of a plant or flower in your house/garden.
<b>New topics: this homework can only be completed after input at school - a dot will be added to let you know when it can be completed.</b>		
Can you use symbols to record what type of weather there is each day for 1 week where you live?	Draw a picture and write a sentence about what you did at the weekend.	Read a story with someone at home. Write a sentence about what you liked about it.
Ask a grown up at home about how their school was different to our school today. Draw a picture or write a sentence about something you found out.	Practise some skills that you have learnt in PE - draw a picture or take a photograph of yourself doing this.	Write about what it means to be a good friend.

In Year 1 homework will follow a 2 weekly cycle. The children will alternate between choosing a homework task from the grid above, then a maths homework task. They will complete both in their Homework Book. When homework has been completed the box can be coloured in to show it has been completed.

Homework can be written in pencil (**at least one sentence including capital letters, full stops, gaps between words and spelling using phonics as much as possible**), pictures can also be drawn using pencil crayons or photographs can be stuck in the Homework Books.

Homework should be returned on a Wednesday and new homework will be issued on a Friday.

In addition, please could you hear your child read for 10 minutes per day, these can be books from home or the library.
