**Term dates** for this school year are also attached. Parents are reminded not to take their children out of school during term time. Applications for authorised absence are available in the school office and must be completed as soon as the need for an application arises, thank you.

Further to the letter about school meals sent out in July, please find attached a copy of the **autumn term menu**. Please advise the office as soon as possible if your child's meal pattern has changed from last year. Children in years Reception, year 1 and 2 will continue to receive Universal Infant Free School Meals. The cost of a school lunch for years 3, 4, 5 and 6 is £2.30, payable on Parent Pay. If parents are in receipt of certain benefits they may be eligible for Free School Meals, forms are available in the office.

A reminder to parents of children in year 6 that the deadline for applications for high school is 31st October, further information available in the school office.
