Dear Parent / Carer,

We have received an updated code of conduct for the use of the **school buses** from NYCC. The majority of the content is about the expected standards of behaviour from the children whilst on the buses, which we know the children from Askwith are aware of and demonstrate. However, it is made clear that it is the parent / carer's responsibility to stay with their child until the bus arrives in the morning and be there to meet them when they get off the bus. We will be reminding the bus companies that they should not let a child off the bus unless there is someone to meet them and to otherwise bring them back to school.
