**Coronavirus update**—We currently have two children who have had a positive PCR (1 in class 3, 1 in class 4) and are now learning from home. If your child has COVID type symptoms a reminder to please get a PCR test. We have been advised that Lateral Flow Tests should not be used for anyone with symptoms. If your child tests positive during half term, please inform school via [askwith@ycatschools.co.uk](mailto:askwith@ycatschools.co.uk) as, in line with our Contingency Plan, further preventative procedures may be put in place if the number of cases reaches a threshold. Thankyou for your support.

**Parents' evenings** for all children from year 1 to year 6 have been taking place this week. Parents' evenings for N and R will now take place after half term.

The **nasal flu vaccinations** took place in school yesterday, if your child was absent or consent was not given in time, but you would like them to receive the vaccination, there are catch up clinics available, see attached.
