Thankyou to all parents for your support and best wishes during our **Ofsted inspection** this week, I will share the official result with you when it is received.

Thank you to Mrs Brown who came into school on Monday to talk to the older children about the **Green Belt**. The children are now aware of the reasons why green belt land should be protected, balanced against the need for more housing in certain areas.
