Following the latest government advice, we are now able to invite children, not currently in school, for face to face meetings. We plan to do this through a series of **socially distanced tea parties!** It is up to parents whether they would like their children to attend but it will be a great opportunity for the children in each year group to see each other and their teachers. The tea parties will take place on the field. Children can wear home clothes but should be dressed to be outdoors, sun cream / hats or coats as required. Children may bring a picnic blanket or similar to sit on, and should bring a bottle of water. School will provide party food. We are working on a plan B in case of rain but we are determined not to have to cancel. The dates for your diaries are:

Children should be dropped off at the field between 12.45—1.00pm and collected between 2.30—2.45pm. The children in school will be taken to the field to join their year group unless parents advise otherwise and may come to school in home clothes on the day of their year's tea party.

To help plan staffing and cake buying, please can parents email school askwith@ycatschools.co.uk or leave a message on the school phone (by Tuesday 23rd June) advising whether or not they would like their child to join in the tea parties.

A reminder that children currently attending school, should bring their **PE kits** to school every Monday, they will be sent home every Friday for washing. Named **water bottles** and named **sun cream** can be kept in PE bags whilst not in use.

Unfortunately, our deliveries of fresh fruit and vegetables for the infant children's **snack** for break time have not resumed. Parents may send in a break time snack for their child, we request the snacks are healthy ie no chocolate, sweets or crisps.
