Dear Parent / Carer,

As announced last week, because of local road closures and likely congestion due to the Tour de Yorkshire, we will be **closing school at 2pm on Friday 4th May**. All children should be collected between 1pm and 2pm on that day, **the AS Coaches bus will depart school at 2pm, the Emmadale bus is not able to collect the children on Friday afternoon. School will close promptly at 2pm.**

During the morning of Friday 4th May, we are planning an '**open school**.' The children will be involved in a variety of activities associated with the Tour de Yorkshire including creating some **land art** on the school field which we hope will be seen by the cameras in the helicopters!

The **PTA** will kindly be providing refreshments for parents to purchase and have organised for an **ice cream van** to be outside school for children to purchase an ice-cream, ice creams for children will be £1 each.

Parents are invited to stay and join in the activities with their children and watch the women's race as it passes by. Parents should sign in and out of the school office and wear a visitors lanyard at all times. **Parents who are staying should park on the pub car park as the road must be kept free of vehicles for the race.** Parents may take their children home as soon as the roads are open, which we understand will be approximately 1pm. Children will have their school lunches earlier than usual as the race passes at approximately midday. Parents should provide their own lunch if required.
