**Coronavirus update**—We currently have 2 confirmed cases in the year 5 & 6 class and all the children and staff in years 5 & 6 and all those that travel on the bus are currently isolating. Whilst I teach year 6, I did not come into contact with either case and therefore do not have to isolate. Please continue to inform school if any member of your household has booked a PCR test and please follow the latest government guidance. As announced on Monday evening, the roadmap is progressing to the final stage on 19th July. However, North Yorkshire County Council have advised that all current restrictions should remain in place until the end of term. We will update you via email on Monday 6th September re: any changes / relaxation of rules that will be possible for next term. However, please be aware that we intend to keep the staggered drop off / collection times as this has greatly eased the parking problems.
